



# QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REPORT

## 2017 Q1-2

First and Second Quarter's data for the Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care's 2017 Performance Management Plan.

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This report was created by the COHHIO HMIS team using Ohio Balance of State HMIS data. It is built according to the project and system performance goals set by the Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) board in the [Performance Management Plan](#) with direction from the Ohio BoSCoC Performance and Outcomes Committee.

All HMIS-participating projects in the Ohio BoSCoC are included in this report. Projects that are part of the Continuum but that do not participate in HMIS send data to the CoC and are monitored quarterly but their data is not included in this report.

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## Executive Summary

The Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) marks its second quarter of 2017 with some improvements and some struggles as an increase in homelessness begins to show in the data. Most of the goals set for the various project types by the CoC are being met!

To highlight the CoC goals not quite being met, our Emergency Shelters and Permanent Supportive Housing projects are inching toward their Income goals slowly but surely, while our Transitional Housing projects are coming very close to achieving the Exits to Permanent Housing and Income goals.

Rapid Rehousing projects are also indicating an increase in their clients' Income at Exit since last quarter. Last quarter, Rapid Rehousing did not meet its 2 year Recurrence goal, but this quarter, they did. There is a slight decrease in the Length of Stay for Rapid Rehousing, which is a goal we are meeting, but perhaps too well. Shorter stays in Rapid Rehousing are good for those individuals and households who do not need the assistance any longer, but as we begin to target those with more barriers, it could be important to keep some households in Rapid Rehousing longer. And finally, more unreliable Move-In Date data has caused fewer providers to meet their Rapid Placement goal. Move-in dates must be recorded accurately in order to measure for this goal.

The Ohio BoSCoC has four PATH Street Outreach projects that vary widely in their programming and capacity. Our Street Outreach goals are new this year and there is training under way for our PATH teams on entering data and achieving CoC goals. We would like to note that the Columbiana County Mental Health Clinic PATH team is meeting both goals consistently!

As a system, the Ohio BoSCoC is meeting a little over half of its goals. Unfortunately a goal that we met last year but have not yet achieved this year is Exits to or Retention of Permanent Housing for ES, SH, TH, and RRH. In looking more closely at where the largest decrease in permanent destinations occurred, we found that Emergency Shelters are showing a 3% decrease in permanent destinations over last year's data.

The other goals that we are not achieving as a system are the Number of Homeless Persons goals. Now that the Point in Time data has been finalized, the numbers show that overall homelessness in the Ohio BoSCoC is increasing, except for Veterans. The stark difference in the outcomes for homeless veterans indicates that the work to coordinate a system that can end veteran homelessness is paying off. As Coordinated Entry is implemented across the CoC, hopefully the overall numbers will fall as well.
