

# Bridges: The Opportunity


 Authorizes "care and placement" for foster youth who left the custody of an Ohio PCSA at 18 years old until age 21 (Bridges)

 $\circ$  Implementation – December 13, 2017

- Appropriation of adequate funds by general assembly
- Approval of an amended Title IV-E Plan by HHS

## **Bridges: The Program**

- $\circ$  Not an extension of foster care but a benefits program
- $_{\odot}$  Extension of Title IV-E benefits
- $\circ$  Housing and case management services
- $\circ$  Voluntary
- $\ensuremath{\circ}$  Separate from current post-emancipation supports



- $\circ\,\mathsf{Care}$  and <code>Placement</code> of <code>ODJFS</code>
- $\circ\,\ensuremath{\mathsf{Must}}$  meet at least one of the program criteria

#### **Bridges: Eligibility Criteria and** tivities

o Secondary education or a program leading to an equivalent credential; Enrollment in school to receive high school diploma

• Enrollment in GED program

 $\,\circ\,$  Is enrolled in an institution that provides post- secondary or vocational education;

- · Public or private 4 year college or university
- Community college
- Vocational programs
- Technical schools




#### **Bridges: Eligibility Activities**

- $\circ~$  Is participating in a program or activity designed to promote, or remove barriers to, employment;
   CCMEP


  - Job CorpsJob skills training
- Is employed for at least eighty hours per month;
- Regular employment AmeriCorps
- Internship/Externship



 Is incapable of doing any of the above activities due to a medical condition, which incapacity is supported by regularly updated information in the person's case record or plan.



- o State administered program with the option of contracting out responsibilities
- Regional approach to service provision
- Request For Grant Applications (RFGA) released in June
