Data analysis for the Ohio Balance of State
Continuum of Care's 2018 Performance
Management Plan

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This report was created by the COHHIO HMIS team using Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) HMIS data. It is built according to the project and system performance goals set by the Ohio BoSCoC Board in the [Performance Management Plan](#), with direction from the Ohio BoSCoC Performance and Outcomes Committee.

All HMIS-participating projects in the Ohio BoSCoC are included in this report. Where applicable, measures are now (as of 2018) counting households instead of individual participants except where otherwise stated. A household is defined as any group of 1 or more clients who present together for homeless services. (A shelter that served 3 households of 1 and 3 households of 3 would be considered to have served 6 households and 12 individuals.)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This year the Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) Performance and Outcomes Committee changed the way we are calculating many of the CoC goals laid out in the Performance Management Plan. The main change is that we began to look at and count outcomes for households instead of individuals. This change caused many of the outcomes to miss the goals. For example, last year, a successful exit to permanent housing for a large household would count as a successful exit for each person in the household, whereas if we are only counting households, that exit to permanent housing would only be counted once this year.

On each of the project type summary pages, you will notice “up” and “down” arrows to indicate whether this quarter’s numbers are greater than or less than last year’s numbers. If the arrow is green (regardless of its direction), it means the outcome has improved over last year’s numbers, and if it is red, it means the outcome is heading in the wrong direction. On measures where the calculations from last year to this year are too different, these arrows have been omitted because comparisons cannot be made properly.

Another difference this year is that the committee decided it was time to finally split out Non-Cash Benefits goals from Health Insurance goals, so this is the first year we are measuring these two separately. It seems that most Non-Cash Benefits being counted in previous years were Health Insurance, because the numbers for the Non-Cash Benefits are quite a bit lower and are missing the goal across nearly every project type, whereas the Health Insurance goals are being met across all project types. Projects in the BoSCoC will need to really make a conscious effort to improve the rates at which households are exiting with mainstream benefits in order for us to meet this goal.

This year the Committee also added a measure for average VI-SPDAT scores for Rapid Rehousing and Permanent Supportive Housing projects. There is currently no goal set since this is the first time we are looking at this data. Thus far, there are many households entering permanent housing without scores at all, which is likely due to delays at the agency level in implementing the new Coordinated Entry workflow which rolled out in January. We are hoping to see improvements over the coming year, especially in regards to the low average scores we are seeing for many of the PSH projects.

Most project types are also missing the CoC’s goals to increase household income. This most certainly has to do with how this is being calculated now that we are only counting households instead of individual increases.

On System Performance goals, the Point in Time (PIT) Count numbers show a decrease in overall homelessness. We are holding off on reporting our chronic numbers at this time due to a data discrepancy this year in relation to Disability data. While we are meeting most of our other system goals, we are not showing improvement over last year.
