This report was created by the COHHIO HMIS team using Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) HMIS data. It is built according to the project and system performance goals set by the Ohio BoSCoC Board in the [Performance Management Plan](#), with direction from the Ohio BoSCoC Performance and Outcomes Committee.

All HMIS-participating projects in the Ohio BoSCoC are included in this report. Where applicable, measures are now (as of 2018) counting households instead of individual participants except where otherwise stated. A household is defined as any group of 1 or more clients who present together for homeless services. (A shelter that served 3 households of 1 and 3 households of 3 would be considered to have served 6 households and 12 individuals.)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Executive Summary

In 2018 the Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care (BoSCoC) Performance and Outcomes Committee changed the way the CoC calculates many of the CoC goals laid out in the Performance Management Plan. The main change was to look at and count outcomes for households instead of individuals. This change caused many projects to miss the goals. For example, last year, a successful exit to permanent housing for a large household would count as a successful exit for each person in the household, whereas this year with the revision to counting households, that exit to permanent housing was only counted once.

On each of the project type summary pages, you will notice “up” and “down” arrows to indicate whether the reporting period’s numbers were greater than or less than last year’s numbers. If the arrow is green (regardless of its direction), it means the outcome has improved over the last reporting period’s numbers, and if it is red, it means the outcome is heading in the wrong direction. Goals that cannot be compared to last year’s numbers because of the changes to how they are calculated will not have an arrow at all.

In 2018 there was a noticeable increase across all project types for households returning to homelessness after a permanent exit from any project. The largest increase in Recurrence lies with the Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) and Rapid Re-Housing (RRH) projects, in both cases, the 6-month Recurrence rate almost doubled as compared to last year. More analysis is needed to determine the cause of the significant increase and whether it reflects concerns or a lowering of barriers to entry and/or more intentional targeting of resources to households with past experiences of homelessness.

Rapid Re-housing projects had a little more unreliable Move-In Date data over last year, but despite that, more projects achieved the goal for Rapid Placement into Housing

A lot of differences over last year can be attributed to counting households instead of individuals this year.

The Ohio BoSCoC met most of the goals for the system-level performance measures except for the measures focused on decreasing homelessness among Veterans and chronically homeless. The 2018 Point-in-Time Count data showed a 1.25% increase in Veteran homelessness over the previous year, and a 9% increase in chronic homelessness. The CoC will continue to analyze these numbers and to work to implement strategies that will help drive those numbers back down.

Although the Ohio BoSCoC met the other system-level performance goals, the CoC did not perform as well as the previous year. The CoC will continue to monitor these measures closely.
