Ohio BoSCoC Project Funding Awards

In addition to \$16,369,464 in funding for renewal projects that HUD awarded the Ohio BoSCoC for the FY18 CoC Competition, HUD awarded two new projects to the CoC. New Project awards include **\$482,316 for a Region 9 Rapid Re-housing project** and **\$1,756,056 for the DV RRH Bonus project**. Total new project funding awarded is \$2,238,372.

The DV RRH Bonus project was designed to work with victim services providers located in 14 of the 17 Ohio BoSCoC Homeless Planning Regions in the CoC, and will be administered by the Battered Women's Shelter. Since the initial grant request was for a one-year term, the full \$1.7 million should be available to provide RRH assistance and services to DV survivors on an annual basis going forward. This is great news.
