Bikes For All People is a non-profit community outreach project of Community Development for All People. **B4AP** provides predictable, reliable access to bicycles and cycling-related resources with a special focus on supporting those who rely on bikes as their sole means of transportation. We meet this mission by offering community building activities.

Open Shop

The **B4AP** shop located at 934 Parsons Ave. on Columbus' South Side is a professionally equipped shop with high quality tools. The shop is open to approved applicants in the community who want to maintain their own bikes. Our staff and volunteers offer free expert advice and support.

Maintenance Classes

Monthly classes teach people to perform basic maintenance and adjustments on their bikes. Classes are open to all people and are always free of charge.

Group Rides

B4AP offers group rides for people of all abilities. Rides teach safe cycling and group-riding. Rides are open to all and free of charge. Current rides include weekly Slow Rolls on Thursday evenings and bi-monthly hard training rides on Saturdays. Check Facebook for ride details each week.

Youth Outreach

B4AP offers several opportunities for youth. We are a job site for the Summer Youth Employment Program. We offer classes for youth that teach bike maintenance and safe riding skills. These programs provide free bikes and helmets to participants. We also refurbish and distribute for free small kid bikes and helmets. As of February 2019, we have distributed over 860 bicycles and 1000 helmets free to youth and children since our opening in September 2014.
