

# Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care 2019 CoC Project Evaluation Scoring and Preliminary Ranking Results

## Purpose of this Listserv Message

This message announces the release of 2019 CoC project evaluation scoring and ranking results for Ohio BoSCoC renewing CoC Program projects.

## Background Information

Every year, the Ohio BoSCoC evaluates the performance of renewing CoC projects and uses those results to inform ranking of CoC projects within HUD's CoC Competition Project Priority Listing. This ranking involves, in part, placing projects into Tier 1 or Tier 2 funding categories. Moreover, these project evaluation results inform CoC project funding decisions, particularly when HUD requires cuts to overall CoC Program funding.

## Project Evaluation Ranking

When projects received the exact same project evaluation score they were randomly ranked.

## Appealing Project Evaluation Results or Ranking

Renewal CoC project recipients may submit appeals of final project evaluation results and/or final CoC project ranking. **Appeals must be emailed in a letter to the CoC Director ([ericamulryan@cohhio.org](mailto:ericamulryan@cohhio.org)) by Friday, May 17, 2019.**

Late appeals will not be considered. Submitted appeals must clearly indicate exactly what is being appealed and must clearly demonstrate and explain how the results or ranking were the result of an error in fact or an undue hardship. The Ohio BoSCoC Steering Committee will review all accepted appeals and will communicate all decisions regarding those appeals by **6/7/19**. Steering Committee decisions are FINAL.

## Project Evaluation Results, Ranking, and Funding Recommendations

HUD has not yet released information about funding availability for the FY2019 CoC Competition. Therefore, the Ohio BoSCoC Steering Committee has not yet made funding recommendations for renewal or new CoC projects. Once funding availability information is released, the Ohio BoSCoC Steering Committee, with approval from the CoC Board, will identify a recommendation for funding renewal and new projects.
