### **Unit Inspections**

The CoC team has confirmed that at this time neither ODSA's HCRP nor HUD's CoC Program has waived or provided flexibility around housing inspection requirements for projects like Rapid Re-Housing or Permanent Supportive Housing. However, the CoC team believes more guidance around this should be available soon.

### **ODSA HCRP Guidance**

ODSA has communicated the following to HCRP Lead agencies:

While efforts are under way to better understand the needs of local organizations through the nine Continua of Care, please provide information about specific needs to OCD. If your agency needs to modify its current budget to allow for greater expenditures to meet the agency's response to COVID-19, coordinate with your grant manager to expedite a grant amendment. While this does not change the amount of your award, it may allow some agencies to be more responsive. To avoid any delays, you can implement activities prior to approval of the grant amendment.

Providers of HCRP funds for homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing assistance may perform virtual meetings with clients to the extent possible. As such, partner agencies will need to coordinate with the Lead Agency to determine parameters on how such a process would work within the Region.
