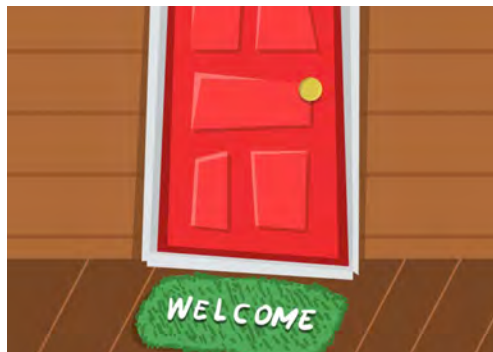

 - Centers around providing housing first and voluntary services as needed and desired
 - Assumes that everyone is ready for housing

- Harm Reduction
 - Strategies and ideas aimed at reducing negative consequences associated with substance use
 - Built on a belief in, and respect for, the rights of people who use substances
 - Goal is to keep people alive and encourage positive change

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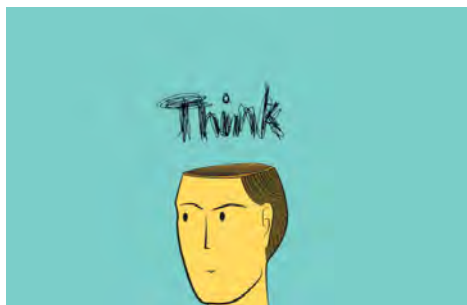
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Scenario 1:
