Submitting Required Program Documents

As noted in the 2021 CoC Competition Plan and Timeline document, some renewing projects are required to submit evidence of Housing First practices, Chronic Homeless prioritization, and evidence of compliance Coordinated Entry prioritization processes.

Non-HMIS participating projects are also required to submit APRs for the 1/1/20 – 12/31/20 reporting period.

Documentation and APRs are due to ohioboscoc@cohhio.org by April 23, 2021

Final Project Evaluation Reports

The final HMIS Project Evaluation Reports will be available in Rme on May 7th, 2021. No corrections to HMIS data for project evaluation purposes will be permitted on or after May 7th.
