Ohio Balance of State Continuum of Care Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Updates CDC Issues Limited Eviction Moratorium

Purpose of this Listserv Message

This message informs CoC members of the newly issued eviction moratorium

Target Audience

All homeless assistance projects in the Ohio BoSCoC.

Temporary Eviction Moratorium

On August 3, 2021, the CDC issued an order temporarily halting evictions in communities with substantial or high levels of community transmission of COVID-19. The order expires on October 3, 2021.

Like the previous eviction moratoriums, this order prevents evictions for covered persons for non-payment of rent. This more limited order, however, only applies in those counties experiencing substantial or high levels of community transmission of COVID-19.

The CDC further clarified that if a county is not currently experiencing substantial or high levels of community transmission, but later does later while this order is in effect, then that county will be subject to this order on the date it began experiencing substantial or high levels of COVID-19 transmission.
