





PHDP • If awarded, there will be 6-9 months (April/May 2022) of planning which includes: • Drafting a BoS Coordinated Community Plan (CCP) • Developing a BoS Youth Action Board (YAB) • Identifying potential projects needed to meet BoS youth homelessness needs • After planning it's anticipated a process (likely RFP) will be established for interested regions/communities to apply for funds to operate youth dedicated projects • Several weeks of application review to select awardees within the BoS • Selected regions/communities are anticipated to begin YHDP implementation in the fall/winter of 2022


