HUD's Equal Access Rule

- Three total rules focused on ensuring fair and equal access to housing for all Americans, regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, non conformance with gender stereotypes, marital status.

HUD's Equal Access Rule

- The first rule, issued February 3, 2012, is the "Equal Access to Housing in HUD Programs Regardless of Sexual Orientation or Gender Identity"

- Determination of eligibility for housing assisted by HUD should be made available without regard to actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity, or marital status

HUD's Equal Access Rule

- The second rule, issued September 21, 2016, is the "Equal Access in Accordance with an Individual's Gender Identity in Community Planning and Development Programs Rule"
- Providers who operate single-sex shelters using funds awarded through CPD are required to provide all individuals, including transgender individuals and other individuals who do not identify with the sex they were assigned at birth, with equal access to programs and services without being subjected to intrusive questions or documentation.

HUD's Equal Access Rule

- The third rule, issued November 17, 2016, is the "Equal Access to Housing in HUD's Native American and Native Hawaiian Programs – Regardless of Sexual Orientation or Gender Identity"
- Applies to HUD's Native American and Native Hawaiian Programs

2022 CoC Competition

- CoC Competition opened August 18, 2021
- Deadline to submit November 16, 2021
- \$2.656 billion available in FY2021
 - Over 400 million more than 2019
 - \$77 million for non-competitive YHDP
 - \$102 for DV Bonus projects

YHDP

- YHDP Round 4 application was submitted on July 30th
- One application was submitted by COHHIO on behalf of the entire BoS (remaining 70 counties without existing YHDP)
- Anticipated award announcement is the end of September/early October

YHDP

- **If awarded**, there will be 6-9 months (April/May 2022) of planning which includes:
 - Drafting a BoS Coordinated Community Plan (CCP)
 - Developing a BoS Youth Action Board (YAB)
 - Identifying potential projects needed to meet BoS youth homelessness needs
- After planning it's anticipated a process (likely RFP) will be established for interested regions/communities to apply for funds to operate youth dedicated projects
 - Several weeks of application review to select awardees within the BoS
- Selected regions/communities are anticipated to begin YHDP implementation in the fall/winter of 2022

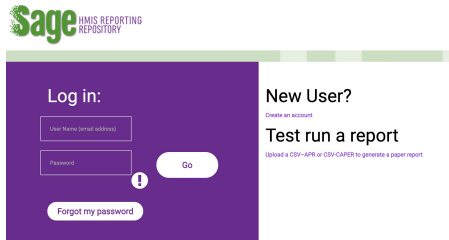

General Program Reminders

Annual Performance Report (APR):

- Must be submitted in Sage no more than 90 days after grant end date

General Program Reminders

ESG-CV Notice Highlights:

- Funds are not subject to match requirements
- New Eligible Activities:
 - Sponsor based rental assistance
 - Renter's Insurance
 - Laundry Service
 - PPE
 - Vaccine Incentives
 - Expanded Use of Cell Phones and Internet
- Can provide rental assistance above FMR
- 60 days of housing stability case management
- Removes 24 month limit on services and rental assistance
- Program participant must not have annual income that exceeds Very Low-Income limit for the area (not 30% AMI)

General Program Reminders

ESG-CV Landlord Incentives:

- Signing bonus equal to up to 2 months of rent
- Security deposit equal to up to 3 months of rent
- Paying costs to repair damages incurred by participant while still residing in the unit
- Paying costs of extra cleaning or maintenance

Landlord Engagement:

- Utilize ESG-CV notice and additional funding to work with landlords and help clients obtain housing
- Work to build rapport with landlords
 - Hold landlord engagement events
 - Create fliers or have individual conversations

General Program Reminders

Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA)

- Eligibility:
 - Experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced other financial hardship
 - Demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability
 - "any other evidence of risk, as determined by the grantee"
 - Households with low income
- Eligible Costs:
 - Rent and utilities
 - Other housing expenses
 - Relocation
 - Hotel/motel
 - Internet, etc
 - Housing Stability services
 - Eviction diversion
 - Mediation
 - Legal services
 - Housing navigation

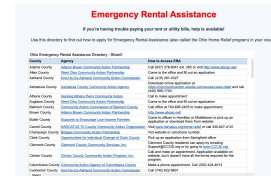

Virtual CoC Program Monitoring

- CoC funded program monitoring will resume in September
- Purpose of monitoring:
 - Ensure CoC funded programs are compliant with HUD regulations
 - Also to ensure that the most vulnerable in our communities seeking assistance are receiving the best services possible

Virtual CoC Program Monitoring

- Monitoring will occur virtually
 - Monitor will reach out to providers to schedule date and request necessary files
 - Program participant will submit necessary documents and files prior to scheduled monitoring start date
 - Initial GoToMeeting will be scheduled with participants
 - Monitor will review documents and files remotely within 48 hours
 - Monitor will reach back out to participants to schedule exit interview
 - Follow-up monitoring letter will be emailed within 30 days of virtual monitoring completion

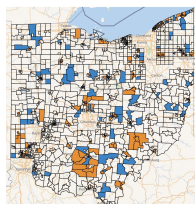
