#### 2.1 sites:

- Akron completed contract with COHHIO; working on local agreement with United Way; touching base weekly; working on hiring; holding focus groups in early May; will use existent payment process; housing pool is going to be challenge in tight market and thinking through the housing timeline
- Columbus completed contract with COHHIO; working on local agreement with CMHA and HFF; staffing considerations to meet HBAH requirements; housing has identified entity with couple buildings and others with additional spots for master lease.

- Work plan review key milestones and progress noted (see meeting packet)

- Staffing and training requirements

  - Question: what if sites want to deviate from the HBAH staffing requirements?
    - Barb to follow up with Akron and Columbus to clarify need for clinical supervision and explore if there are alternative approaches to LISW.
    - 2. HFF leadership is meeting with Maureen at CelebrateOne to discuss further.
- Landlord recruitment & move-in support
  - No additional support needed now
  - Can discuss through office hours when questions emerge

#### 7. Next steps

- Barb to issue meeting notes, organize voting process for the evaluation plan, follow up on ARPA next steps, and clarify HBAH staffing requirements with Akron and Columbus.
- Akron and Columbus to identify and forward nominations for CLC community advisors to Douglas and Barb. These will be voted on at next meeting. Tameka and Barb will conduct orientation.
