Notice of Funding Opportunity Now Available

The Administration for Children and Families (ACF), Administration on Children, Youth and Families (ACYF), Family and Youth Services Bureau (FYSB) announces the release of the Fiscal Year 2023 Street Outreach Program (SOP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO).

The Street Outreach Program provides street-based services to youth who have run away from home, are experiencing homelessness, and youth living on the street who have been subjected to or are at risk of being subjected to sexual abuse, prostitution, sexual exploitation, and severe forms of human trafficking in persons. These services, targeted in areas where youth congregate, are designed to assist such youth in making healthy choices and providing them access to shelter as well as basic needs, including food, hygiene packages and information on a range of available services.

Grants awarded under this announcement will have a start date of September 29, 2023 and will be for a 36-month project period.
