Effective October 1st, all HMIS End Users must collect and enter client information in accordance with the updates. R minor and R minor Elevated will be updated in accordance with the data standards changes. Expect that some reporting may not reflect the new changes for the first few weeks in October. The COHHIO HMIS team has prioritized updating Clarity HMIS data entry screens and will move to updating the custom apps when that work is complete.

Reporting

General Reporting

Sage will be updated to accept FY 2024 APR, CAPER, and CE APR in October. If you have an active grant open in Sage, we recommend submitting before September 30th or the APR component may need to be redone using the FY 2024 APR.

SSVF Reporting

Exports need to be pulled on or before September 30th. The COHHIO HMIS Team received conflicting information about repository upload due dates from Bitfocus (the HMIS vendor) and VA HMIS TA. If you are unsure about your repository due date, our team recommends that you reach out to ssvfhmis@abtassoc.com.

COVID Assessments and Questions

The COHHIO HMIS Team and HMIS Joint Advisory Committee made the determination that for the Ohio Balance of State CoC, COVID-19-related fields would be discontinued. Our team will complete the removal of these fields while updating HMIS to match the new data standards.
