Purpose of this Listserv Message

This message provides an update on the availability of R Minor Elevated (Rme).

Target Audience

All CoC members.

Background Information

Effective October 1, 2023, the Ohio BoSCoC Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) implemented updated data elements to comply with HUD's updated HMIS Data Standards. These changes caused the CoC's custom reporting platform, Rme, to malfunction, thus the information available in Rme was temporarily not updating.

Rme Available and Updating

As of October 30, 2023, the Ohio BoSCoC custom reporting platform, Rme, is now fully available and updating daily. This means providers can once again return to using Rme for their HMIS Data Quality (DQ) work and to access current Prioritization Reports.

Because Prioritization Reports are available and current, providers should discontinue use of alternative reports and HMIS data as part of their interim prioritization processes.
